STUDENT DRIVING AND PARKING LOT REGULATIONS

The following regulations are set forth in the best interest of all students. Parking on school grounds is a privilege. To maintain this privilege a student is expected to exhibit the responsible behaviors and appropriate attendance patterns as outlined in the student handbook. This privilege may be withdrawn from any student who violates any of these regulations.

- 1. Application process: Each student who drives a car to the school whether it belongs to him/her, a family member or a friend must register his/her car at the Main Office with the Residency Clerk and affix a parking permit sticker on the **REAR** window. **An insurance card, car registration papers, and driver's license must be shown**.
- 2. Students may park only in the areas provided for student parking. Improper parking, such as wrong areas, blocking roadway, straddling lines, for example, are prohibited.
- 3. School grounds speed shall not be in excess of 10 miles per hour as per Connecticut State Statutes. All traffic signs and lights must be obeyed. Cars must be driven in a safe manner at all times.
- 4. Unattended cars must be locked.
- 5. Students may not go to their cars during the school day unless authorized by an administrator.
- 6. Attendance Criteria: A parking permit will be rescinded from any student who is chronically late to school.
- 7. Citizenship Criteria: A student must exhibit appropriate behavior as outlined in the Student Handbook. A student who is assigned an out-of-school suspension for three (3) days or more or repeatedly in a ten (10) week period will lose his/her parking privileges for a minimum of ten (10) weeks.
- 8. Appeal Process: A student may appeal a parking related decision (other than a parking ticket) to the House Principal.
